SAWN ON BED WALLING STONE

Our signature walling stone is produced using sawn, cropped and tumbled techniques for a more traditional look. You can request specific sizes or opt for standard industry bed widths of 100 mm.

We saw our stone on the bed in four industry standard course heights - the face is then cropped by guillotine, exposing shell formations. After that, the stone is cropped at random lengths for an authentic feel and finally tumbled to remove sharp edges.

Walling stone is available in three beautiful English limestones to satisfy different budgets and planning requirements.

CROPPED WALLING STONE (NEW AND RECLAIMED)

We carry stock of both new and reclaimed cropped local walling stone. Laying this stone takes a little more skill and creativity, but it gives a wonderfully traditional result, especially when used in extensions or renovations of period properties or in dry stone walling. It's also easy to match up to existing stone in period properties.

SAWN ON BED WALLING STONE

CLIPSHAM

Our signature stone, which is commonly referred to as “Stamford Stone.” A warm honey colour, it has become a firm favourite with planners from North Lincolnshire to the Southern Cotswolds.

GREETHAM

A paler local stone with less variation, popular throughout Lincolnshire and South Yorkshire as an alternative to magnesium limestone, frequently specified by planners. This stone is particularly suitable for larger course heights.

IRONSTONE

A distinctive and highly sought after red coloured limestone, with blue veining, Ironstone country stretches from Leicestershire through Rutland, Northamptonshire and down to the Cotswolds.

CROPPED WALLING STONE (NEW AND RECLAIMED)

GREY CROPPED

Quarried in nearby Northamptonshire, this product lends itself to courses in 2, 3 and 4" and in bed widths of 150 mm. It is often preferred as an alternative to reclaimed walling due to its ability to achieve a similar look with less intensive labour and lower wastage. Sold in bulk bags which average 3–3½ m².

CREAM CROPPED

Quarried in the Cotswolds, this honey coloured limestone is available in 3, 4 & 5" course heights, and 150 mm on bed. Sold in bulk bags which average 3–3½ m² heights.

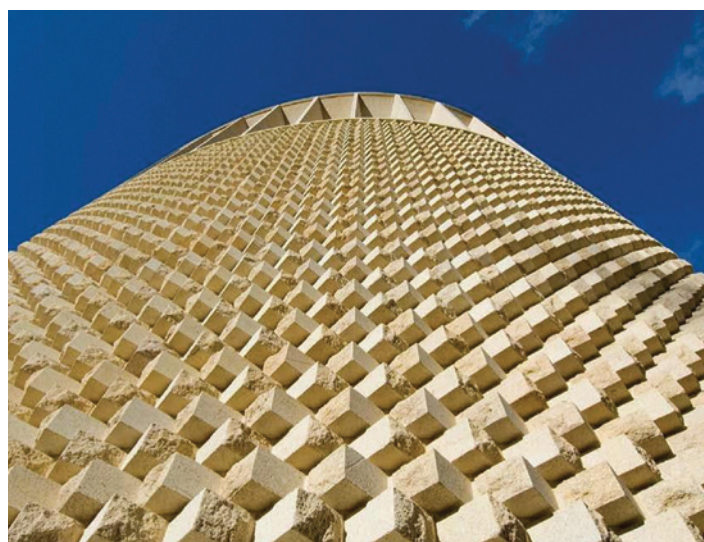
